U.S. Forest Service – Ozark-St. Francis National Forests

Per the June 4, 2020 - "Status Update of Recreation Areas webpage" – The Cove Lake Recreation Area (Logan County) opened for camping. Eighteen campsites are reservable and cabins are available. Cabins reservable for weekends, only. The swimming area, bathhouse, and concessions are also open; parking is limited to fifty vehicles.
